

Just a quick update to ask for your prayer support.

Our month of missionary visits has begun!

Last week we had a visit from a couple who have been missionaries in Mexico for the past forty years. We had an encouraging time with them as they shared some amazing stories of their lives on the mission field. During their visit we spent an evening witnessing to and sharing with the mother of one of Ava's friends. Kathleen has been witnessing and praying for L. for over a year now and this night provided an even greater opening for her to continue to speak into her life. ***Please pray that the eyes of L. heart will be opened and she will find her acceptance and love in her savior, the Lord Jesus!***

This week, we will be hosting a missionary team from neighboring Switzerland. The team of five will be evangelizing on the streets with us and will also accompany us to the refugee camp. We pray for many openings, especially as one of the team speaks perfect Arabic and was herself once a refugee. As we have experienced in these past few weeks, when God is on the move, our enemy is not sleeping. We know, satan will do anything in his power to thwart our attempts to further the kingdom of God. We also know that he is a defeated enemy and cannot stand against the power of God. But it is warfare nonetheless and in this knowledge we ask you to ***stand with us in prayer: for boldness instead of timidity, for power despite our weakness, and for the right words to be spoken at the right time to the right people. We pray for seeds to be sown, for lives to be changed, for healings to take place, for salvation to come.***

We have a second prayer request: As many of you know, Kathleen's mother Diane was diagnosed with lung cancer two years ago and at that time underwent an operation. The doctors have now recommended Chemotherapy and Diane has today started her second treatment. ***Please pray with us that Diane may endure the chemo without the usual side effects and that her healing will be manifested. Please pray for her husband Joe and for all the family during this time.***

Kathleen would dearly like to spend a month in the summer supporting Diane and Joe and is of course tossed to and fro with her desire to assist her mother and her commitments to the mission, of which she is an integral part. There is also a matter of cost in returning home for a second time this year. ***Please pray that God might release the finances for her and Ava to return home, should this be His will.***
